2018 Quick Reference Facts:

CAL FIRE's Fire Prevention (FP) Grants Program provides funding for local projects and activities that address the risk of wildfire and reduces the wildfire potential to surrounding communities. The three funded activities include: 1.) hazardous fuel reduction 2.) fire planning 3.) fire prevention education. In addition to reducing the threat of wildfires, the Program also focuses on reducing the emission of carbon from wildfires.

- **Eligible Applicants**
 - Certified Local Conservation Corps
 - Fire Safe Councils recognized through the California Fire Safe Council
 - Other Non-profit organizations with a 501(c)(3) designation
 - Local government within or adjacent to the State Responsibility Area (SRA), including
 - Incorporated Cities and Counties
 - Fire Districts
 - Community Services Districts
 - Water Districts
 - Resource Conservation Districts
 - Special Districts
 - State Agencies and Native American Tribes
- **Fire Prevention Project request amounts**
 - Capital Equipment cannot exceed \$100,000
 - Indirect Costs may not exceed 12%

Tentative Timeline for the Grants:

- Grant Application Opens: May 9th, 2018
- Grant Application Closes: June 6th, 2018 at 3:00 PDT
- Grant Approvals: July 2018
- Grant Agreements sent out: July 2018
- Grant Agreements due: September 28th, 2018
- Grant Projects Completion: March 15th, 2022
