The Fire Safe Council of San Diego county has a variety of workshop offerings to increase your community's wildfire preparedness.

FIRE OPERATIONS IN THE WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE WORKSHOP (WUI)

Our Fire Operations in the WUI Workshops teach the principles used by firefighters in suppressing wildland fires and protecting structures in the WUI. As more neighborhoods move closer to wildland areas, trainings like this one become increasingly more essential. Participants learn about fire behavior prediction and how to apply this knowledge to their community's topography, fuels, weather, and home construction. The course shifts to the field in the afternoon; where participants will apply the knowledge learned in the morning to community examples.

LAST CHANCE SURVIVAL SIMULATION WORKSHOP (LCSSW)

The Last Chance Survival Simulation Workshop curriculum expands on "Ready Set Go", a widely accepted statewide standard for wildfire preparation, and our WUI Workshop. This workshop was developed to help people navigate the variabilities of a wildland fire scenario and to be prepared if evacuation isn't an option. We expand on topics including, but not limited to, recognition primed decision-making, open-source fire intelligence, contingency planning, and other practices that may enhance the likelihood of surviving in a fire entrapment scenario.
