***ARE YOU PREPARED TO EVACUATE YOUR ANIMALS IF THERE IS A WILDFIRE?
LEARN WHAT TO EXPECT IN AN EVACUATION IF YOU HAVE LARGE AND/OR SMALL ANIMALS.***

The evacuation clinic will be conducted by the San Diego County Animal Response Team (SDCART) with Lt. Dj Gove, Emergency Coordinator for the County of San Diego, Department of Animal Services.

Discussion will focus on having a plan for your horses/animals, shelter in place, TEP, evacuation, ensuring trailers are connected correctly, and working with horses/animals who may not load well. Dj will also share information about ways to help others evacuate including personal liability.

Representatives from CAL FIRE, San Diego Sheriff Department, County of San Diego Animal Services/SDCART, Ramona West End Fire Safe Counsel and SDG&E will be here to answer any questions.
